150 1745 San Xavier beginnings. Inds and padres (Mariano) had been back and forth btw SA and this place (Ranchería Grande) for years apparently.

156 1746 (Apr 13?) A ms founded and padres there - but not yet authorized. Crops planted etc.

181 1747 (Dec 23) Three ms authorized etc.

271 1755 (By Aug 23) Had retired to San Marcos for safety.

274 1756 (July) Still at San Marcos

276 1757 (Jan 25) Ms.est'd at present New Braunfels...River still known as Guadalupe, now Comal. Suggested "good thing to occupy a post ~~there~~ betw SA and San Saba." Apparently the New Braunfels ms. was abandoned 1758, after San Saba ms. was destroyed by the Apaches "since with insufficient garrison it could not exist because of the multitude of enemies."

278 1758(Mar)

1757 San Saba ms and presidio established.  
1758 " " ms destroyed but presidio was continued and efforts made to reestablish ms.
