The San Saba trail continued no rthwestward fx om Fredericksburg and proceeded to Fto Mason, then to it . Sau Sebe in the eenter of Menard county. Then it ontinued as the upper stegecoach road to in paso through the Green mountains; thence up the main Concho river, south of Castle wountains, crossing the Pecos at Amigrant Crossing (?): thence up the Pe.cos river and Delawere creek and on to 4. Paso.

This upper thail to 11 paso, however, was not successful, because of difficulty in finding the needed amount of water al ong the way the other roed through the Devis hountains and, Jt. Davis was the more traveled way. Spanish Pass, north of Boerne, is so named because of this 01d Spanish trail through there. This trail was establishea some time in t729.
