My dear Mr. Ayres:

In my letter to you of August 28th following our trip as far west as Bay St. Louis, I referred to a resolution adopted at the Bay St. Louis meeting, suggesting that the next conference of states and communities between Pensacola and New Orleans be held at New Orleans, and in your letter of September 12th to me, you wrote as follows:

"The annual meeting at New Orleans is not impossible, if they want it."

A letter has been received by Mr. John T. Cochrane, who was chosen President of the Gulf Conference last March, from Mr. R. H.
