The station was a round open shed in a place about twenty-five
 yards long. It was divided into three rooms.
 These were occupied by the families that came for the stock, which consisted
 of one hundred and fifteen cattle, one hundred and thirty
 fifteen head of cattle, two hundred and thirty sheep and goats, two
 hundred water, fifteen lambs, and sixteen goats.
 The station and the ranch have the necessary corrals for the feeding
 of the cattle here in a line with the station.
