4 In May I learned that letterheads were printed without my name as managing director on them, but with these employees carried at the top. I thereupon returned to San Antonio, May 20-24, long enough to compel restoration of my home on the letterheads, and any other printing, and the names of employees, if printed at all, to be placed properly. Other things must needs wait for I was due in Jacksonville, then at Washington.

I now find that in the period of my absence the San Antonio (has received 27500 00 Only 560 was paid on rent account, and essentially nothing on other important accounts. These other creditors were given my eastern address to write to me. An audit is being made f of these accounts. Also an alysis of axamama disbursements.
