

Marginal Highway around the United States.

WHEREAS, It is important for the safety as well as for the commercial development of the Country that there should be a marginal highway extending around the United State; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Old Spanish Trail Association, in meeting assembled at Houston, Texas, this the twenty-fifty day of July, A. D., 1919, recommend and urge that the Government take all necessary steps to promote and build such a highway at the earliest practicable date, in co-operation with all of the border states of this country; that the highway across the Southern Border of the United States from the Atlantic Ocean to the Pacific Ocean, known as the Old Spanish Trail Highway, be designated at the Southern portion and route of such marginal highway; Be it further

RESOLVED, That we endorse House Memorial No. 5 of the Florida Legislature of 1917, and that we do hereby adopt and amend said Memorial so as to include the State of Mississippi and the City of Los Angeles, California, and the Senators and Representatives of all states named therein, to read as follows:

"BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF FLORIDA:

That the Congress of the United States be and is hereby memorialized to make such appropriations and to pass such legislation as to empower the Government to take over the highway known as the Old Spanish Trail Highway from Miami and Tampa, Florida, through the Gulf Coast States to Los Angeles, California.

Resolved further, that the Senators and Representatives in Congress be and they are hereby requested to place this important

RESOLVED, That the Government take all necessary steps to promote and build such a highway at the earliest practicable date, in co-operation with all of the border states of this country; that the highway across the Southern Border of the United States from the Atlantic Ocean to the Pacific Ocean, known as the Old Spanish Trail Highway, be designated at the Southern portion and route of such marginal highway; Be it further
