

Revised Mileage Table

MARCH 1, 1928

Road and bridge construction totaling \$70,000,000 now completed. An all-weather, all-year road now exists across the continent except one county in Alabama east of Mobile Bay, and that will be standard built summer of 1928. All the old distressing sections are now replaced with modern construction. One-half the mileage is paved with additional paving being continually laid. The Old Spanish Trail is a United States Highway for its whole mileage. State maintenance forces are in service on all sections.

The mileage is logged by specially equipped cars of the Automobile Club of Southern California working in co-operation with the Old Spanish Trail to correctly fix and standardize the mileage records.
