Minutes of the

Called Meeting of the

OLD SPANISH TRAIL ASSOCIATION

Houston, Texas, Friday, July 25, 1919.

A meeting of interested communities along the route of the Old Spanish Trail was held in Houston, Texas, July 25th, 1919, for the purpose of re-establishing in a larger way, the Old Spanish Trail Association.

The meeting was called to order by H. F. MacGregor of Houston, who, after a short address of welcome, stated that the first order of business would be the election of a Temporary Chairman and a Temporary Secretary.

On motion duly seconded, John B. Carrington of San Antonio was elected Temporary Chairman of the meeting; and, on motion duly seconded, Herbert Bayliss of Lake Charles, La., was elected Temporary Secretary.

After Mr. Carrington had taken the Chair, he addressed the meeting as to its aims and purposes.

On formal discussion, a suggestion by Will L. Vining of Orange resulted in Mr. Harry Locke of Los Angeles, California, giving a statement on the Old Spanish Trail proposition as it stood today, and that it would be necessary to further the work in hand.
