WHEREAS, It is important for the safety as well as for the general development of the Country that there should be a Marginal Highway around the United States, and that the Government should hereby petition the Governor and the Campaign Committee for this Bond Issue Resolution, and any other group of officials in charge, to take the necessary steps, if possible, to allow the people to vote on some definite program for the issuance and spending of this money to create and build such a highway at the earliest possible date, in co-operation with all of the States; and only do we believe that the people of Texas can be induced to vote for the bond issue, and because their vote so recorded will be mandatory on the Legislature morally, if not legally.
