If you can get better information from a life of
Leo X, ¹⁵¹³ or about the battle of Ravenna 1512 it would
be a great help. Since I have been over so many old
Spanish words, I am inclined to accept their
word on the subject. In the preface to the "Crónicas
de España" by Borcia (D. Gabriel algarraza & cans) written
1728 he writes "que los mas seguros historiadores sobre el
descubrimiento de la Florida por Juan Ponce de Leon en el
año 1512" that the most secure historians place the discovery
of Florida by Juan Ponce de Leon in the year 1512, and later
on "El año de 1513 se celebró en España a dos pretendidos"
The year 1513 he says (or established) in Spain his pretendition
in translation may not be accurate. Hakluyt and
some writers before Ferrer say that Ponce sighted
Florida on Wednesday, March 7, 1512 and landed
April 3rd (which would be the Easter day). I haven't
opened up my tape lately yet so will look you to
be sure in writing of land.
