

## WHAT ARE THE REMEDIES?

- 1 The President must resign.
- 2 Colp is an employee. His self-exploitation and blundering are going to stop, now.
- 3 This Executive Committee of citizens will stand guard against any more looseness, or personal exploitation. And they have pledged themselves to help build up this work.
- 4 The civic and commercial organizations of San Antonio will be asked at once to appoint representatives to a meeting to plan their co-operation. San Antonio is the logical city for the Headquarters, and San Antonians have honored themselves in the past in the support they have given. Henceforth, it should be laid down as just that the Headquarters city should, thru her civic organizations, help the Executive Committee and the management work out the complex problems and policies inherent in a project of this magnitude.

5 A meeting of the Texas Directors ~~met~~ with the Executive Committee and the Managing Director will be sought for Friday or Saturday, November 24 or 25, at San Antonio, and all councilors members and friends of the Old Spanish Trail will be called to meet in San Antonio for conference at that time.

Texas has done much for this work; it has been their memberships that have sustained it thru the past three years. The East and the West are doing big things in their sections, and now they are ready to stand with the Texas workers and help forge a unified, national force behind this project, and they look to Texas for the leadership that shall accomplish this.

6 A national convention must be held. A program, embracing many questions of importance, is ready and waiting the action of the membership; questions that should not be settled by individuals. According to the constitution the annual convention should be held in November, but the conduct of the President made it impossible. A convention, when held, must have good representation from all districts and states, and legislate in the interests of the Old Spanish Trail as a ~~multinational~~ whole. March 1922 a Four-state Conference was held at Mobile, largely attended by the officials and people of Florida, Alabama, Mississippi and Louisiana. That Conference, on invitation from the New Orleans civic organizations, is to meet the first of the year at New Orleans, and ~~is to be held at New Orleans~~ ~~and to be held at New Orleans~~. The civic organizations of that general section are all of them actively forging the Old Spanish Trail interests into an active construction program. The Washington results grew out of that work. Those people are making plans for the next Conference, to not only carry eastern work far ahead, but they want the highway leaders of Washington, and army officials, and the officials of all the CST states with them. If the ~~annual~~ convention can be joined with this eastern conference at New Orleans, it would bring a mighty force together and accomplish many things.

7 The Chamber of Commerce of San Antonio thru its Highway Department can, and it is believed, will render valuable service. Travel is now good westward all winter, and the whole United States should know it. An automobile expedition from San Antonio to Phoenix, Arizona, in December or January, would probably be joined at Phoenix by Californians led by the San Diego Chamber of Commerce. Rotary, Kiwanis and other civic clubs, could be officially a part of this expedition, as these clubs have done in the East, and work of far-reaching value to the Old Spanish Trail, and for the convention, and for national publicity, will result.

Unless this ~~work~~ CST work can go on with a clean administration and a nationally visioned program, it will die.

Therefore, in brief:

San Antonio

Thru this Executive Committee and the civic organizations, ~~thru~~ San Antonio's part will be settled -- and San Antonio will do her full part.

Thru this gathering of Texas members, Texas conditions will be settled.
