

INVENTORY OF PROPERTY IN THE RESEARCH ROOM AT ST. MARY'S ACADEMY,
112 College Street, Belonging to Herral Ayres, made by Miss Virginia Edgcombe and Bro. Joseph Schmitz, January 25, 1934.

- 1 Desk table, golden quartered oak.
- 1 Large flat typewriting desk, golden quartered oak.
- 2 Swivel chairs, quartered oak, leather-cane bottom.
- 1 Swivel chair, quartered oak, solid oak bottom.
- 1 Arm office chair, quartered oak, solid bottom.
- 2 Steel waste paper baskets.
(Note. One basket is reported but two were left there.)
- 1 Small typewriter table, dark quartered oak.
(Note. There is a two-compartment, quartered oak, desk filing case...but this may have been stored in the large roll-top desk, but is not so listed.)
- 1 Swivel typewriter chair, quartered oak, perforated bottom.
- 1 Sectional filing case, dark oak, with card index section, pull-out leaf section, three letter file sections. *and filed records etc*
- 1 Large roll-top desk, dark quartered oak.
(Note. Contents were listed, but this is to be kept locked so contents not re-stated here.)
- 1 Small roll-top desk, golden quartered oak, containing:
 - 1 book of photo collections,
 - 1 book of Spanish and Mexican collections,
 - 1 book of etching collections,
 - 1 book of Spanish flag studies, colored drawings etc.,
 - 1 book of Old Spanish Trail coat-of-arms, and including photos of my Spanish decoration and certificate etc.
 - 1 book of photographs, entitled Land of Ruins.
 - 1 "Memoirs of Mary Maverick."
 - Desk blotter and pad, pins, clips etc.
 - 3 loose leaf binders.
- 1 Field map of Texas, installed on wall.
- 1 Large craft paper scrapbook of clippings etc.
- 1 Folio of maps of South Texas (complete) and of North Mexico, etc.
- 3 Boxes of Old Spanish Trail material. (Each has inventory on outside and is sealed.)
- 1 Army trunk and contents.
(Note. This was not listed but was left there, and locked.)
