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The "Governors' Palace" was not a governor's palace. It is a fine civic step toward the preservation of the spirit and character of the Spanish past. Truth respecting that past, however, will not come until research has uncovered more, and more carefully interpreted what is uncovered. has

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Ch. W. P. S. The granary at San José was the old first church; therefore a rare and very interesting relic. But there is work yet to be done to completely prove this. The profaning done at that "restoration" probably can never be corrected now.

There are considerable data developed to establish the correct history respecting the foregoing, and other history now crudely misrepresented. These illustrate the necessity for collective Round Table discussion and interpretation before any conclusions should be given as historically correct, and these also illustrate the difficulties that must be faced before historical facts can be established in the public mind and San Antonio spared the odium of amateurish work.

Affiliations. Coordination with all other historical agencies is as important to complete understandings as Round Table work is to local studies. We can organize broad and constructive institutional coordination, and we must do it. There is history in and around San Antonio to be brought out that can make San Antonio the shrine of the American traveler, and there is rich ~~historical~~ field for literary writers, authors and historians. As President of the Old Spanish Trail I can command transcontinental coordination—I already enjoy such cooperation and assistance. The K.C. Historical Commission of Texas is laying a splendid foundation for this Texas work--because of the K.C. work much is possible now that, a few years ago, was hopeless. The K.C. is identified with St. Edward's University; our work should bring credit to St. Mary's University. Frank cooperation with all other historical agencies in Texas is of course essential. Some of our associates, who are also members of other societies, are helping with this. There is no duplication. The field is too big. Great publications will not come until that field is explored infinitely more than it has been, and source material made ready.
