## TEXAS

- 1 The San Jose Mission book. (pp 18 and 19)
- 2 Tourist map of the old Spanish trails of North Mexico and South Texas. San Antonio, Goliad, Laredo, Monterrey and Saltillo, and other communities, will be interested in this.
- 3 A Handbook for San Antonio; historical facts briefly stated, photos, etchings and maps to embellish it.
- 4 Leaflets of historical studies will follow along in natural course.
- 5 A historical monthly or quarterly. This, an undigested thought; one eminent man is interested in this.

## OLD SPANISH TRAIL

- 1 Highway and tourist map of the Spanish Borderlands; a transcontinental travel and historical compilation. This was ready to be put over when the financial break came in 1929.
- 2 A Handbook of the Old Spanish Trail; its historical background and all sorts of condensed data, including the place-name meanings, and including 50 or more etchings and other hand-work sketches of historical places.
- 3 A book of mission photographs, Florida to California, with brief data and description with each photo-engraving. There are close to 200 very interesting photographs available for this.
