Contributors to this advertising are complaining, members are complaining, and ITY. Colp says the solicitor vas to pay halis the cost of the printing and the solicitor says he wawxumbtumproxawydicins wasn't.

The solicitor vas found overpaid his $75 \%$ commissions, and Ur. Colp said the solic j.tor owed hin and Dr. Johnston some money, and it is stated the printing was given to that incompetent wefree shop because the proprietor oved Dr. Johnaton monoy. This solicitor was sent out again and given $75 \%$ after I had recalled him. Ho also was allowed to indorse and convert checke to his own uso.

About the time of my retum anothor man was sent into admittedy poor territory and given $33 \mathrm{~J} / 3$, and made for himself 100 oo per weok.

A so-called publicity man was sent out and as usual no contract is show, and none of the protecting influences thrown around him. Irportant privileges were turned over to him, without record or restriction so far as mown. Ho passod bad ckecs and lcft unpaid personal bills, and on my return I recalled him, thon he was secretiy sent vestward. Me passed. a bad check tor 20000 in San Diego and disappeared. Intomation is now coming of other misuso of money and of credits.

There ario documonts anä daba of other orude work, but so much detail is not necossary here.

Since Ianvary I (the period of my absence) the San intonio office has had over 850000 , yet no attompt was made to pay the accounts of the Association for the service and matexisls used by the office. No money was aet aejse to issue thesc section maps and travel information, for which something over 3500 oo has beon collected.

I myself was in vixgin territory in the Bast and should have had financial help from Headquarters, and from Texas where three years of work lay behind the office. Instead, I had to produce in the Hast a11 money for those expenses, and for the washineton expenses, and sent money to San Antonio to help this office, and paid 925000 to the cunter Hotel to provent dispossess, and this 25000 is still due me. I gave Mr Colp my personal check in April for 175000 because he claimed to be in distress, snd ho has not attempted to repay that.

The organization cannot continue to exist by such practices. We must show the pooplo, and at once, we are worthy of the trust placed in us, and the linst step is to stop this abuse of their conilaence, and to restore the protective and constitutional provisions to the headquajters work -and this in spito of the prosident if he persists in refusing to accept the wridict of his own fellow citizens and workers.

Then ways must be Sound to cont inue the constructive policies that placed this Highway on the maps of all the OST states as a part of the Pederal system of highways, and as an important transcontinental highway; and that brought about the doclas ation of the sonators and congressmen that this was a basic hichwey of the United itates system and should herpomptyeomploted in the public interesti and that secured the to the netional doiense and asked for its construction according to the best foderal standards as a military necossity.
