In towns requiring more than 10 markings the Association is paying for the markings on a basis of 40¢ per mark, and where the posts are creosoted and have to be shellaced there is an extra charge of 12¢ per mark.


The Association pays for markings only at street crossings or wherever necessary to enable tourists to enter and leave the town without confusion or delay. If it is your desire to have all of the poles marked along the route through your town as a matter of appearance and to advertise the highway such marks as you may desire IN ADDITION TO WHAT ARE NECESSARY AND PAID FOR BY THE ASSOCIATION will be placed by Mr. Gardner if you desire on the above cost basis.

The Association will furnish all material for any extra markings that any town or community desires to have put on.

Before Mr. Gardner can be paid for extra marks it will be necessary for you, or some one having your authority, to check his work, and O.K. the number of marks within your city limits.
