Have yours 21st. Have just had a letter from J.V.Price, Sec. Chamber Commerce, Pensacola, to the effect that Pensacola cannot help OSE work any at present. Inasmuch as Pensacola never has helped, but that on the contrary we have spent considerable money in that section while awaiting their promises to carry their share of expense you can see we cannot go any further in Florida work until the money is available. This means serious losses to you in West Florida - for all my information shpws me you there should delay no longer in the numerous things that would make your highway inviting to tourists.

I would not know how to answer your questions respecting the matters between Tallahassee and Quincy. All such things solve themselves when we begin to develop travel movement; that has been our experience elsewhere.
