We have your letter of May 26th with reference to petition enclosed in regard to the Old Spanish Trail. The resolution as passed by the Commission is as follows:

That Highway No. 3 be officially named the "Stephen F. Austin" highway.

In this connection we wish to advise that in our opinion this would not effect the name or designation of the Old Spanish Trail, as there are several highways in the State which bear the official designation of several trails or routes, therefore, we cannot see why this would effect the Old Spanish Trail as it now stands.
