Incorporated places.—Table 5 shows the population of the incorporated places (cities and towns) in Alabama in 1930 and 1920. In this table the places are arranged in alphabetical order, each followed by the name of the county in which the city or town is located. In Table 6 the population of the more important cities is presented by wards. Birmingham is not divided into wards, but its population by precincts will be found in Table 4.
