

THE STATE OF TEXAS  
COUNTY OF TRAVIS

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This CONTRACT made and entered into by and between the State of Texas, acting herein through its Chief Executive, W. P. Hobby and Mrs. Lipscomb Norvell of the County of Jefferson, parties of the first part, and A. L. Gooch of the county of Travis, and State of Texas, party of the second party;

WITNESSETH:

That A. L. Gooch, party of the second part, agrees to furnish an erect 123 red granite boulders, and place said boulders upon concrete foundations at designated points along what is known as the King's Highway, said designated points being now marked by posts placed on said Highway at a distance of about five miles apart by State Surveyor, Z. M. Zively; that said boulders shall be three feet six inches high, two feet wide and fourteen inches thick; shall be polished upon one side and lettered according to design made by A. L. Gooch, and now in the possession of Mrs. Lipscomb Norvell, said design calling for the following words to be placed upon the same in letters two inches high and one-fourth inch deep:-

"KING'S HIGHWAY  
CAMINO REAL  
OLD SAN ANTONIO ROAD"

In letters one and one-half inch high and one-fourth inch deep:-

"MARKED BY THE DAUGHTERS OF THE  
AMERICAN REVOLUTION AND THE  
STATE OF TEXAS A. D. 1918."

The concrete foundations upon which said boulders shall be set shall be of the size four feet, six inches by three feet, six inches and one foot thick, made of concrete in proportion of one, three and five, that is, one part cement, three parts sand and five parts gravel or crushed rock; that said boulders shall be made and erected as above stated at the expense of said A. L. Gooch, and work finished by April 1st., 1918.

That in consideration of the making and erecting of said boulders, the said State of Texas and Mrs. Lipscomb Norvell, parties of the first part, agree to pay to the said A. L. Gooch, the sum of Four Thousand Three Hundred (\$4,300.00) Dollars, said sum payable as follows:-

Twenty (\$20.00) Dollars per marker or boulder when same is completed and loaded upon car at Austin for shipment, the balance to be paid when said work of placing said boulders or markers is completed, inspected and accepted by the State of Texas, acting through Superintendent of Buildings or some other person designated by the Governor of Texas.

This contract made and signed in triplicate, this 27th day of December, A. D. 1917.
