Lieutenant Joseph E. Johnston, then under Robert E. Lee, made a survey of the Fredericksburg road in 1854. It starts at the Cathedral, then up the old San Pedro ditch to San Pedro Springs--then shows Leon Creek--then Scott's Crossing on the Guadalupe--then Fredericksburg itself. Mr. Locke remarks that while only these several points are shown there is a lot of latitude for guesswork left as to just what Lieutenant Johnston may have had in mind.
