however, to three or four gentlemen who
can probably help you out.

For truly, Choctaw, Atsapa and other
languages in the Gulf region you should
consult Dr. J. R. Swanton, Bureau of
American Ethnology, Washington, D.C. For
Delaware and other Algonquian languages
you should refer to Dr. T. Michelson,
same institution. For German and other
languages west of Texas you should con-
sult J. P. Harrington, same institution.
And for New Mexico Spanish a very
good man to refer to is Prof. Aurelio Es-
pinosa, Stanford University, Calif.
