On January 1st, the State Road Department will take over the Old Spanish Trail Highway or the east and west road across Florida, as a State Highway, and put same in good condition. The Department will have the use of 300 convicts, hereafter, and all of the automobile license money, in addition to appropriations. The County Commissioners of Jackson and Gadslen counties will meet in Quincy, Fla. October 20th, to go over the Apalachicola bridge plans, which have been returned by the War Department with their O.K. Work will be commenced in the near future so cheer un!
