altho how in the name of good business I can make \$6000 go that far and give satisfaction I do not know. I'm like the nigger though, I appreciate the confidence shown me.

January 24th I sent you from Crowley a complete statement of the Louisiana sondation situation, showing the towns in detail. That was a creditable showing for your towns; it was the larger cities that were out of the fold. That statement showed you had remitted to us \$1050 00

If Louisiana will pay without more delay and without more expense to us a half of the 1928 pledge (\$5000) of which \$1050 has already been paid us we can start the travelog work within 24 hrs. I put this this way as something definite you may work to.

After the travelog is out we can confer more easily as to the disposition of the remaining \$3000 (more or less) to be paid. It should be remembered it will take fully 50% for administration; at least until there is more general and more prompt payments of funds.

I have worked as I have for the travelog because I know it will be worth all the funds you pay in for all purposes, and more--once out it will keep on doing good all over the United States.

Wilson is sick in Growley. We cannot keep jim longer in Louisiana and I cannot keep backing him when he is not at work. He is efficient and honest. The statement of January 24th showed his costs in Louisiana about 30% and this was among the smaller towns. That is a good showing. He should have been in Alabama and Florida by now. I am waiting to consult him.

Can you arrange in some way to give us business assurance of the time and the amount you can and will make available?
