Acknowledgment is made of your letter of March 24, 1924, in which you ask whether we have any law in this State governing advertisements by billboards.

We have no statutes in this State with reference to advertisements by billboards, except the Prohibition Law, which, of course, prohibits the advertisement of intoxicating liquors, and a statute which prohibits the use of railroad crossing signs for advertising purposes.
