Under separate cover I am sending you a photograph of the Victory Bridge, across the Apalachicola river near Chattahoochee, Florida.

The arch spans of concrete are 110' in the clear, the bascule span provides a 100' clear channel for river traffic; the height of the finished roadway above the normal water level is 44'; from foundation line to roadway the height is 74 feet; foundations are on rock at a depth of 25' delow bed of river.

I trust that this photograph will be of value to you in carrying out your work on the OST.
