at Menardvillo by the San Saha river in Menard comnty.
Later great stagecoach trails from San Antonio developed northward to Fredericksburg and to this forto From Fredericksburg a trail branched mestward and southwestward thru the Big Bend country to CChihwaw, Mexio co. From this trail another branched at Comanche springs (Ft. Stockton) and pessed thru Itmpla Canyon, Ft. Devis and the Davis Mountains, and an other passed north of the Davis mountains, ereating the ola stageco ch trails from San Antonio vestward to Fl Paso and thzu to Celifornia.

At Menardville is still to be seen the zuing of a a old Spanish fort. The traditions are the Spanish had a rich mine there the location of which has become Iost and that the fort mas in protection of that industryo

The San Saba Trail from San Antonio, acoording to Mro Locke and the map which he has, Ieft the front of san Bernando Cathedral at san Antonio. All old roads start from the plaza in Iront of this Gathedral. The San Saba Trail proceeded to San Pedro Springs; thence somewhet east of but more or less parellel with the present roed to Leon Creok, crossi ng it at the present orossing; thence almost on the $x$ esent road to the spring at Leon Springs.

From tue it follows the old leftohend or stage roed to Boeme : thence by the present roed to the Spanish Pess, thru the pass to the right of the present road; thence down the $\nabla$ frlley of fink ${ }^{\circ}$ s Creoln crossing the Guadm slupe at Scott's Crossing; thence up BIock Greok, crossing Bi8.H111 at or about the present orossing.

Across Grape. Creek at the present crossing and Pexdenalss Greek at about the present crossing; thence to Fredericksburg along about the present road.
