

Shreve and his TSP commissioners recently contacted either H.B. Ayres had recalled him.

Q What methods for checking up collections to establish correspondence of remittances by individuals?
A Machine numbered receipt books were in stock with single pre-printed forms and methods for producing the money paid by the people. These receipts were not checked and given as items in the book considered this time of an auditor to establish Shreve's accounts, then it was shown he had been overpaid.

Q Are collections bonded as GST regulations and printed matter required?
A No collector was bonded after H H A left for the East. Redbrick was bonded; but he was sent out two weeks after H H A returned and protested against the business conditions.

Q Are collections remitted in full to Headquarters, or do men convert checks and funds to cash on account?
A Shreve for some time has been allowed to endorse checks and convert the money to himself, retaining only 5% to the office.

Q Are there unfulfilled obligations due by field men, for which they have already been paid, and if so what is the Association liability thereunder?
A It will probably cost \$1000 to prepare and print the maps and travel information, and to perform other services intended or promised the people. There is also a pending account for 10,000 books printed in connection with this work. There are accounts and liabilities paid even the accounts for this credit but they have responsibility.

Q What is the total of funds collected from the people with the promise of service to be rendered, with the service still un-rendered? And what money is in the treasury, or as cash, to perform this service?
A The San Antonio office has had since January 1, 1922, the time H H A left, over \$1500 on September 6, 1922 the bank balance was \$1734. It will require \$200 to \$2500 to pay certain liabilities, to re-check, prepare, print and issue properly the section maps and travel information promised the people under the plan. It is to correct improper marketing and to carry the office until some means can be found to obtain new funds for all this liability.

Q Will the Board of Directors of the Chamber of Commerce as it has refused support or endorsement of the GST?
A A so-called budget was submitted to them which was justly condemned. That "budget" was improper, unauthorized and not worthy the approval of thinking men.
