

and names and other conditions are being considerably revived largely because this Old Spanish Trail work is continually emphasizing the old Spanish history. We observe today new hotels, public and private buildings, realty developments and many other works are reflecting decidedly the old Spanish period. Right now the most prominent architect of San Antonio is spending three months in travel studies in Spain and intends to publish a book on Spanish architecture as adaptable to this country.

I trust, therefore, you will see that in our efforts to have the Spanish Government well represented at this St. Augustine celebration we are doing it because we believe it will be pleasing to all future generations if this old Spanish history, interest, architecture and art can be revived and kept alive in this country.
