

Extract from minutes meeting Board of Directors, Gulfport Convention
January 29, 1921

September 30, 1920

"The Managing Director explained he had never had any salary authorized simply because the Association had not been in a position to pay a salary. He also explained he could not afford to go on this way altho he would continue to give his first thoughts to this work. A general discussion disclosed a unanimous sentiment that proper provision should be made for compensation and a resolution was adopted:

"That the Board of Directors recommends the Managing Director be paid a salary to date from the beginning of the work, September 1, 1919, the amount to be left to the President, with Mrs. Riegler joining and reporting as to the sentiments of the Board."

Received by M.D.A. from beginning to January 27-28, 1921 (Gulfport Convention Certified copies of all minutes were sent to all Directors and by them accepted.

Received following Gulfport Convention to Dec. 31, 1921 (\$100.00 in Gulfport accounts makes \$750.00 total 1921)... 650 00

Received in 1922 to date 1300 00
Mrs. Riegler afterward said to Mr. Ayres that the message to the President from the Directors was that \$500 per month would be agreeable.

From September 1, 1920 to September 31, 1922, 5 years and 4 months at \$250.00 per year..... 1250 00
Due M.D. Ayres, under agreement, \$500 00
