Aktract from minutes meeting Board of Directors, Culfbort Convention January 29, 1921

"The Langing Director explained he had never had any salary authorized simply because the Association had not been in a position to pay a salary. He also explained he could not afford to go on this way altho he would continue to give his first thoughts to this work. A general discussion disclosed a unanimous sentiment that proper provision should be made for compensation and a resolution was adopted:

"That the Board of Directors recommends the Lanaging Director be paid a salar; to date from the beginning of the work, September 1, 1919, the amount to be left to the President, with Irs. Riegler joining and reporting as to the senti ents of the Board."

Certified copies of all minutes were sent to all Direcors and by them accepted. Wood in

Mrs. Riegler afterward said to Mr. Agres that the message to the President from the Directors was that 3500 per month would be agreeable.
