He would certainly make a good one and would tie the Commission a good deal closer to Mobile。 It is little things like this that will make it easier for you in the future, but of course you have had so many big things to handle you probably didn't have time to think of littie things, but after all this is really the big thing when you darit from a true angle.

Orange County voted her $\$ 700,000$ and I sent you a clipping to that effect.

Shreve has been tied up in Houston now for two weeks except he ran down to Beaumont and Orange on the train and secured eleven ads and this will enable us to go ahead and get out the Section Map as soon as he can finish up some of the uncompleted towns between Houston and San Antonio.
