- QD. T. Colp stated that under the terms of his contract with the Cld spanish Trail he received \$250 a month for three-fourths of his time to act as manager of the western department of the Association; that he received \$2\cdot\ o per mile for the use of his ar while being used in the performance of his duties as an employee of the Association; that he also received his actual expenses incurred in the performance of these duties including amounts spent for upkeep of his car; that he understood his contract to run until the meeting of the association in convention in November; but that he tendered his resignation effective immediately.
- Pending discussion of the motion, Mr. Walthall moved: That all employes be requested to orntinue in the employment of the Association under the terms of their present contracts until said contracts have been entered into. The motion was agreed to; and it was further agreed: I. that Mr. Colp, Mr. Thompson, and Mr. Shreve, as well as pr. Johnston should go to Houston at once for the purpose of assisting the Motor League of gath mexas and the citizens of Houston in themsands insum campaign for a bond issue of six million dollars in Harris County to be voted on on Nevember 7th; 2 That Mr. Thompson's expenses in making the trip from Houston to attend the meeting be paid; 3. That Mr. ghreve's expenses in making the trip to attend the meeting be paid; 4. That Mr. chreve be paid \$44 per week while engaged in assisting in the bond issue campaign in Houston.

Adjournment followed.
