5. Nogales to Tueson, Artsons, beginning 1801. A large repp of marison was built below and above the present Mexican border. Mission San Xarter del Rac, 9 mt. south of Tueson, ranks with San José at San Antonion in statellness; it Indian descendants of the Primeria Alta of the patient. Time-decor mission, near Nogales, he now a National Moniment.

Tucson is a gem of the mystic deaert, home of the University of Atrona, a city of Spanish tradition and atmosphere, a resort loved by many.

6. San Diego, California, settled 1769, first mission and first settlement in California, two centuries after Saint Augustine, Florida. California was inaccessible and barren; generations of failures preceded this successful effort, then privation of the control of the control of the control of the in seeds, palms, shrubs and livestock and the missions became estates of hospitality and abundance.

California was the latest supreme effort of the Spaniards in America. Their period there lasted hardly a half century before Mexican independence destroyed Spanish power northward, and then followed the years of turnoil before the Americans entered and finally succeeding in reducing the country to orderly government.

The padres built twenty-one missions from San Diego northward to San Francisco and above. Some are destroyed; some preserved. The Californian love of beauty, sentiment and history has led them to preserve in cong. story and works, the culture, legenda and lays of those years of the Spanish grandees.

The conquerers were often cruel, the explorers heroic, the colonizers were empire builders, the padres with their Government coperating built temples to their God seeking the temporal and spiritual good of their red brothers.

The Spanish empire in the Americas, true to the principles of all life, rose from the soil through travail and turmoil to flourish and flower then to decay and die.....but they left a heritage of romance, culture and works for the people of today and for the years to come.
