RESOLVED: That the Old Spanish Trail Association in
Convention assembled at Tallahassee, does hereby most heartily
endorse the plans of the National Highways Association as set
forth in their letter of April 10th, 1917, to the Honorable Woodrow
Wilson, President of these United States.

RESOLVED: Further that the peculiar fitness of the
Old Spanish Trail for a marginal military highway along the Gulf of
Mexico and the Mexican border be also called to the attention of the
President of these United States, and that the Old Spanish Trail be
and hereby is offered to the Government for such purpose.

RESOLVED: Further that the Secretary be instructed to
send copy of these Resolutions to the said Honorable Woodrow Wilson,
President of these United States.
