Whereas, this association regards it as fundamentally important that the coast fortifications of our country should be connected by permanent highways, built under the supervision of the War Department, and

Whereas, this association representing the Southern coast and Mexican border, ~~from Florida to California~~, has tendered to the Government the Old Spanish Trail from Miami, Fla. to San Diego, Cal., therefore be it

Resolved, that this association solemnize the United States Government, conveying its belief that a national ^{Coastal} military highway, girdling the entire coast line and Mexican border, connecting the coast fortifications from Maine ~~to the North~~ on the Atlantic coast in the northeast, to Washington ^{State} on the Pacific coast in the Northwest, should be completed by the Government, under the supervision of the War Department;

Resolved that a report of the tender of the Old Spanish Trail, be ~~made~~ transmitted to the various highway associations or state highway departments controlling other existing highways that would form links in the proposed Coastal Military Highway, with the respectful recommendation of similar action.
