RESOLUTIONS FOUR-STATES GULF COAST CONFERENCE
Florida--Alabama--Mississippi--Louisiana
Mobile, March-20th-21, 1922.

RESOLVED, that we the people of the Gulf Coast of the States of Florida, Alabama, Mississippi and Louisiana, petition and urge the Congress of the United States to continue the program of appropriating \$100,000,000 annually for federal aid to highway building. The highway program in all states suffers from the present uncertainty. The people are aroused and ready to cooperate with their own local aid and support to bring about completion of the national trunkline highways but the undertaking is so gigantic they must be put in a position to plan their work for years ahead with the assurance their plans can be carried out.

We further urge upon the Congress that the present state of unemployment in the United States, and the condition of so many of our honored ex-service men demand the greatest possible chance for work be afforded them that the congress can provide.
