My dear Mr. Ayres:-

I have your letter of the 7th. Since writing to you, I talked the matter over with our senator, Mr. Russek, He is with us, and suggests that you and the Advisory Board write to each senator, advising them of the conditions that will arise when interstate highways associations are interfered with in their development of traffic, and which would affect every district of the state in the same way.
