6．Mr．Diekinson was asked to talk on what he had heard on the road， He mentioned the roads in Colorado and＂yoming and soid the people Were behind them．$\overline{\mathrm{H}} \mathrm{e}$ said the roads through West Iexas were so poov that he would never encourage anyone to thave them，even though he would like to boost Iexas and San Antonio．Said tourists were drop－ ping down from the North and if San Antonio had bid for tourist tre－ vel，she would not have gotien as much as could be sotten if the road question was solved．
