My dear Mr. Daron:

I want to tell you something, out of appreciation for your service. Have had trouble with my eyes past two years but it now appears your service was all right and that the glasses ordered here in substitution for yours were bad.

August 1928 you fitted me. These served me well but Feb. 1930 I had a check-up here and the specialist ordered new glasses. I sent that prescription to you and you had those lenses made for me.

Ever since using these San Antonio glasses I have had break-downs but my physician, not suspecting the glasses because prescribed by a reputable practitioner, has been searching for some organic trouble. The past month we have subjected my eyes, and my past prescriptions, to careful checking. I have signed copies of all my prescriptions. You will remember the glasses I was wearing when you fitted me, were hurting, and were bad; and they were by a reputable doctor.

It develops your prescription was good---also that these San Antonio glasses, which you had made for me at Mobile, were accurate according to prescription, but the prescription bad and the cause of my troubles.

Have not ordered new lenses yet. There is advantage buying here because of adjustments at times, but am disgusted with the sort of service have had here, and the restrictive combinations by which they get big prices and give no protection against blundering.

What will new lenses cost thru you. Think will use orthogon, soft tint. Wish had saved the old lenses of yours; they would still be quite good, particularly for bad times. Do you have "bad times" there?
