X JACUMBA: ^(Spring)*Said to be derived from the center. Pro. He-coon-hoo. (Sp.)*

SAN DIEGO: Saint James. Other forms Santiago and Saint Iago. (Sp.)
San Diego, a Franciscan saint of the 15th century, was born at Alcala, Spain. The mission name is San Diego de Alcala.

Santiago was the Spanish name applied to the saint.
