Text, p 360, briefed: Carried by Sph troops in Mex Indep war; now in museum at Mex City. Adaptation of raguled cross of the Sph Bourbons, which may also be seen in the earlier flags of Ostend and Biscay (G 1143 and 1146--the Beaumont collection, 1705), but with an added feature of crown-crested coats-of-arms on the four ends of the cross.
