

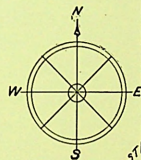
# "THE SAFE WAY"

**Daphne**—Ten and one-half miles from Mobile, across beautiful Mobile Bay. A fascinating resort town of ante-bellum days with excellent Fishing and Bathing facilities; a quiet, healthful town. Location of the Daphne State Normal School.

**Loxley**—Eleven miles east of Daphne. Noted for its level and fertile farming lands, Pecan and Satsuma Orchards, Poultry and Trucking Farms. "The Heart of Baldwin County." On Trunk Highway.

**Sage Bridge**—Twenty and one half miles from Loxley; location of the old Nunez Ferry, a crossing of the Perdido River used from remote times. A charming location for camping and with good fishing in the Perdido River.

Eighteen miles from the Sage Bridge to Pensacola.
