Limits of Bartow city ^a extended in 1925, and parts reverted to precincts 3 and 38, respectively, in 1927. Eagle Lake town incorporated in 1921, Hillman Heights town in 1923. Polk City town in 1924, and Lake Hamilton and Frostproof towns since no name of Dundee changed from East Winter Haven in 1927. Bradley Junction and Dundee towns not reported separately in 1920. Auburndale, Winter Haven, Haines City, and Lake Alfred towns, incorporated as cities since 1920. Haines City, Mulberry, and Winter Haven city limits extended in 1925, pointed as a city in 1924, part reverted to precinct 28 in 1929. Part of Davenport town reverted to precinct 26 in 1929.

^b PUTNAM.—County redivided in 1924, and parts of Bradford and Clay Counties annexed in 1927. Old precinct 11, coextensive with Palatka Heights town, annexed to Palatka city in 1921.

^b ST. LUCIE.—Old precincts 1, 7, 8, 9, 11, 14, and 16 taken to form Indian River County, and part of precinct 4 taken to form part of Martin County, in 1923. County redivided since 1920. No population in 1930 in that part of Fort Pierce city in precinct 1.

^c SANTA ROSA.—County total for 1920 includes population (61) of old precinct 13, Indian Springs, annexed to it since 1920. Precinct 23 organized from parts of 1 and 5 in 1922 and number changed to 13 in 1923.

^d SARASOTA.—Organized from parts of Manatee County in 1921; county redivided in 1930. Venice city incorporated in 1927. No population in 1930 in that part of precinct 3 outside Sarasota city.

^e SEMINOLE.—Sanford city limits extended in 1923, 1925, and 1926. Lake Mary and Oviedo towns incorporated in 1925. Altamonte Springs town not shown separately in 1920. Precinct 15 organized from part of 6 in 1922, and precinct 12 from parts of 9 and 11 in 1927.
