BY-LAWS

ARTICLE I.

Membership

Section 1. The membership of this Association shall be open to any person interested in the development of this Highway. 1923 CONVENTION

ARTICLE IN The Executive Board

Sec. 2. Amend by substituting the following:

Five directors shall be elected from the headquarters city and these shall constitute an Executive Board to direct the administration of headquarters work, and in this representing the Board of Directors and coordinating with the directors by reports, shark mail votes and meetings of the Board of Directors,

Where administrative duties in these by-laws are lodged with the Board of Directors it is understood the Executive Board shall act in the name of the Board of Directors, and reporting to and being advised by the directors.

Sec. 3. The Executive Board shall organize by electing a chairman and a vice chairman, and shall designate from among its members the Secretary and the Treasurer of the Association. The Executive Board shall also select, or appoint, and fix the remuneration, subject to the approval of the Board of Directors, of the active managing executive.
