GULF COAST CONFERENCE

Mobile, Alabama.

March, 21st, 1922.

It is the sense of the delegates and citizens here assembled from Louisiana, Mississippi, Alabama, and Florida that the Highway Commission of Louisiana be requested to make public as soon as possible definite action as to the completion of the Louisiana links of the Old Spanish Trail, namely, from the Rigolets to Slidell, and from Pearl River Station to the Mississippi State Line.

The people of four states are looking forward eagerly to the completion of the Gulf Coast Boulevard, and until assurance comes from the Louisiana Highway Commission that it will take care of the missing links in that State, the project can not be certain.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That this meeting petition the Highway Commission of Louisiana to make public at an early date their plans toward building their links of this nationally important road. This in order that the various states interested may be encouraged to go forward with work on the highway.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:, That this meeting express its regret that it was impossible for the Louisiana Highway Commission to be present.
